

2025 “JERRY KASER” CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Today and throughout the 2025 Club Championship tournament, the format will be “Match Play (MP).” **MP** is a form of play where a player plays directly against an opponent in a head-to-head **match**. You win the hole by completing it in the fewest number of strokes, you win a **match** when you are winning by more holes than remain to be **played**. The **player** with the fewest strokes on an individual hole, wins that hole, the **player** who wins the most holes, wins the **match**. Total score in **MP** has no bearing on the winner of the **match**.

Below is an example of scorekeeping;

On the East Course, players will play from the Black Tees, unless you are eligible to play from the silver tees as determined by the Costello Rule or age. On the West course players will play from the silver tees, or green as explained in the previous sentence.

The scorekeeper in each twosome will maintain the scorecard and use (+1) if he is up on the hole, (E) if they are even, or (-1) if he is down for each hole.
